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INTRODUCTION

Rent prices in Brooklyn decreased by approximately 2.58% from \$2,741 in June 2014 to \$2,670 in July 2014.



A QUICK LOOK

Rent prices in Brooklyn decreased by approximately 2.58% from \$2,741 in June 2014 to \$2,670 in July 2014. Rent prices increased 4.14% from \$2,564 to \$2,670 compared to July 2013. Listing inventory increased 2% compared to June 2014 from 2,271 units to 2,327 units.

The market appears to have dropped compared to June 2014. The largest percentage increases in rent prices were seen in One Bedroom units in Brooklyn Heights and Cobble Hill. The largest percentage decreases were seen in Studio units in Bay Ridge and Bedford–Stuyvesant.

The largest annual upward and downward shifts in rent prices were seen in Crown Heights and Dumbo respectively. Rents increased 17.5% in Crown Heights compared to July 2013 from \$1,796 to \$2,110. Rents decreased by .3% in Dumbo from \$4,083 to \$4,071.

The Brooklyn rental market appears to be continuing the trends it has exhibited for the past several months. Neighborhoods such as Williamsburg and DUMBO continue to see slower growth, while much of the more rapid expansion is taking place in underdeveloped areas like Bushwick and Crown Heights. In addition, several new luxury developments continue to enter the market in Brooklyn Heights which has caused a surge in prices in the neighborhood. Another notable neighborhood is Cobble Hill. Although its monthly price averages have remained stable, the neighborhood is among the highest in terms of increases in yearly price changes. Brooklyn's yearly progression continues it steady upward pattern, while month to month prices have fallen due to the maturation of inventory on the market in several neighborhoods. Looking forward, this movement will likely be sustained as new developments and conversions will be entering the market at relatively moderate pace in the near future.

Studio Price Trends Over 13 Months














BAY RIDGE

• With the exception of One Bedroom units, this neighborhood experienced a sizeable 8.77% drop in average overall rents compared to last month.












BEDFORD-STUYVESANT










BOERUM HILL

• This month saw a modest overall 3.21% fall in prices, however Two Bedroom units remained relatively stable.











BROOKLYN HEIGHTS

• Rent prices increased considerably compared to last month, but this neighborhood's most notable figure is the 8% rise from July 2013.











BUSHWICK

• With monthly overall average rents falling by a nominal amount the most significant trend to consider is the 11.3% yearly increase in prices, second highest throughout all of Brooklyn.











CLINTON HILL

• All unit type prices fell moderately this month with overall average rents dropping from \$2,602 to \$2,519.











• This neighborhood's average monthly rents remained the most stable throughout Brooklyn falling a trivial .23%.












CROWN HEIGHTS

• This neighborhood claimed the highest year-over-year increase among Brooklyn neighborhoods increasing a mammoth 17.5%.











DOWNTOWN BROOKLYN

• Overall average rents for this neighborhood fell slightly from \$3,284 last month to \$3,239 this month.












DUMBO

• Both monthly and yearly average overall rents remained relatively stable decreasing a minimal 1.95% and .3% respectively.










FORT GREENE

• All unit types experienced a significant drop in average rents compared to last month resulting in Brooklyn's greatest overall average price decrease at 9.56%.











GREENPOINT

• This neighborhood saw marginal fluctuations this month, with the exception of Two Bedroom units which fell by \$223.23.











PARK SLOPE

• Average rents fell across all unit types compared to last month causing overall rents to fall from \$2,679 to \$2,559.












PROSPECT-LEFFERTS GARDENS

• Although this neighborhood's overall average prices fell by 4.53% from last month, the more significant trend is its year-over-year increase of 7.8%.










WILLIAMSBURG


