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INTRODUCTION

WE ARE PROUD TO PRESENT MNS' TENTH ANNUAL YEAR END REPORT



MNS is proud to present our tenth annual Year End Report for Brooklyn, the summation of a year's worth of data collected from our monthly Brooklyn Rental Market Reports. We hope you find this report useful in determining the rental trends in Brooklyn's major neighborhoods, as well as the overall climate of the Brooklyn rental market.

Compared to last year, the average rental price in Brooklyn is down 4.80%, from \$2,947 in 2019 to \$2,806 this past year. The average rental price for a studio fell by 4.74%, from \$2,316 to \$2,206. The average rental price for a one-bedroom unit fell by 4.43%, from \$2,830 to \$2,704. The average rental price for a two-bedroom unit fell by 5.12%, from \$3,696 to \$3,506.

The greatest year-over-year change in studio pricing was observed in Borough Park/Sunset Park, where the average rental price fell by 12.92%, from \$1,679 in 2019 to \$1,462 this past year. Downtown Brooklyn was home to the largest year-over-year change in one-bedroom rental pricing, with the average rental price dropping 8.78% from \$3,547 to \$3,236. The greatest year-over-year change within two-bedroom pricing took place in Brooklyn Heights, where the average rental price fell by 7.16%, from \$5,423 to \$5,035.

NOTABLE TRENDS

Growth and Borough Trends

Downtown Brooklyn (-8.19%) experienced the greatest overall year-over-year price change with Brooklyn Heights (-7.18%) not far behind.

COVID-19 SNAPSHOT, 6 MONTH ANALYSIS

IN ORDER TO BETTER ILLUSTRATE THE IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON THE BROOKLYN RENTAL MARKET, WE HAVE COMPILED AND ANALYZED DATA FROM THE SECOND HALVES OF OUR 2019 AND 2020 MONTHLY BROOKLYN RENTAL MARKET REPORTS. WE HOPE YOU FIND THIS INFORMATION USEFUL IN DETERMINING THE EFFECT COVID-19 HAS HAD ON THE BROOKLYN RENTAL MARKET.

BROOKLYN

Compared to last year, the average rental price in Brooklyn is down 11.70%, from \$3,006 in 2019 to \$2,655 this past year. The average rental price for a studio fell by 10.67%, from \$2,352 to \$2,101. The average rental price for a one-bedroom unit fell by 10.77%, from \$2,863 to \$2,555. The average rental price for a two-bedroom unit fell by 13.04%, from \$3,804 to \$3,308.

The greatest change in studio pricing was observed in Downtown Brooklyn, where the average rental price fell by 18.00%, from \$2,866 in 2019 to \$2,350 this past year. Brooklyn Heights was home to the greatest change in one-bedroom rental pricing, with average rental pricing dropping 19.09% from \$3,556 to \$2,877. The greatest change within two-bedroom pricing took place in Williamsburg, where the average rental price fell by 18.24%, from \$4,076 to \$3,332.







The Brooklyn Rental Market Report is based on data cross-sectioned from over 10,000 currently available listings priced under \$10,000, with ultra-luxury property omitted to obtain a true monthly rental average. Our data is aggregated from the MNS proprietary database and sampled from a specific mid-month point to record current rental rates offered by landlords during that particular month. It is then combined with information from the REBNY Real Estate Listings Source (RLS), OnLine Residential (OLR. com) and R.O.L.E.X. (Real Plus).
