

QUEENS RENTAL MARKET REPORT

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INTRODUCTION



Over the last month, the average rent in Queens has increased by 0.87%, from \$2,250.92 to \$2,270.59.

A QUICK LOOK

Over the last month, the average rental price in Queens increased by 0.87%, from \$2,250.92 to \$2,270.59. The average price for a studio increased by 0.32%, from \$1,876.79 to \$1,882.87. The average rental price for a one-bedroom unit increased by 0.95%, from \$2,180.12 to \$2,200.84. The average rental price for a two-bedroom unit increased by 1.19%, from \$2,695.86 to \$2,728.05. Year-over-year, studios, one-bedrooms, and two-bedrooms all saw their average rental prices increase, by 4.02%, 3.65%, and 2.29%, respectively.

Out of the seven neighborhoods tracked by this report, only two experienced price contractions: Ridgewood (-2.60%) and Jackson Heights (-1.98%). Out of all tracked unit types, two-bedrooms performed the best on a by-neighborhood basis, with pricing falling in only Jackson Heights (-1.69%). This past month, the most expensive rentals could be found in Long Island City. The most affordable studio and one-bedroom units were in Jackson Heights, while the most affordable two-bedroom units were in Ridgewood.

As we approach peak leasing months, rental pricing can be expected to continue increase accordingly.









LONG ISLAND CITY

Thanks to typical rental market seasonality, the average price for a rental in Long Island City increased by 1.79% during May.









ASTORIA

Driven by an impressive 4.57% increase in studio pricing, the average overall rental price in Astoria increased by 2.04% during May.










RIDGEWOOD

Continuing the trend that emerged last month, the average rental price in Ridgewood experienced a 2.60% price correction during May.









FLUSHING

Following last month's large increase, the average rental price in Flushing stabilized slightly during May, increasing by just 1.01%.








REGO PARK

Following two months of price decreases, the average rental price in Rego Park increased by 4.00% during May.









FOREST HILLS

This past month, the average rental price in Forest Hills increased by 1.12%.








JACKSON HEIGHTS

During May, the average rental price in Jackson Heights experienced a correction of 1.98%.


