A QUICK LOOK

BRONX

Over the past month, the average rental price in the neighborhoods analyzed by this report decreased by 1.71%, from \$2,733 to \$2,686. Studio rental pricing decreased by 0.50%, from \$2,226 to \$2,215. The average rental price for a one-bedroom unit decreased by 3.06%, from \$2,715 to \$2,632. The average rental price for a two-bedroom unit decreased by 1.41%, from \$3,259 to \$3,213.

The most expensive studio and one-bedroom units were in Mott Haven; the most expensive two-bedroom units were in Riverdale. Conversely, the most affordable studio, one and two-bedroom units were all in Morris-University Heights.

Compared to this time last year, studio pricing is down by 3.42%, one-bedrooms are up by 5.88% and two-bedrooms are up by 0.77%. Overall, the year-over-year average rental price tracked by this report has increased by 1.50%.

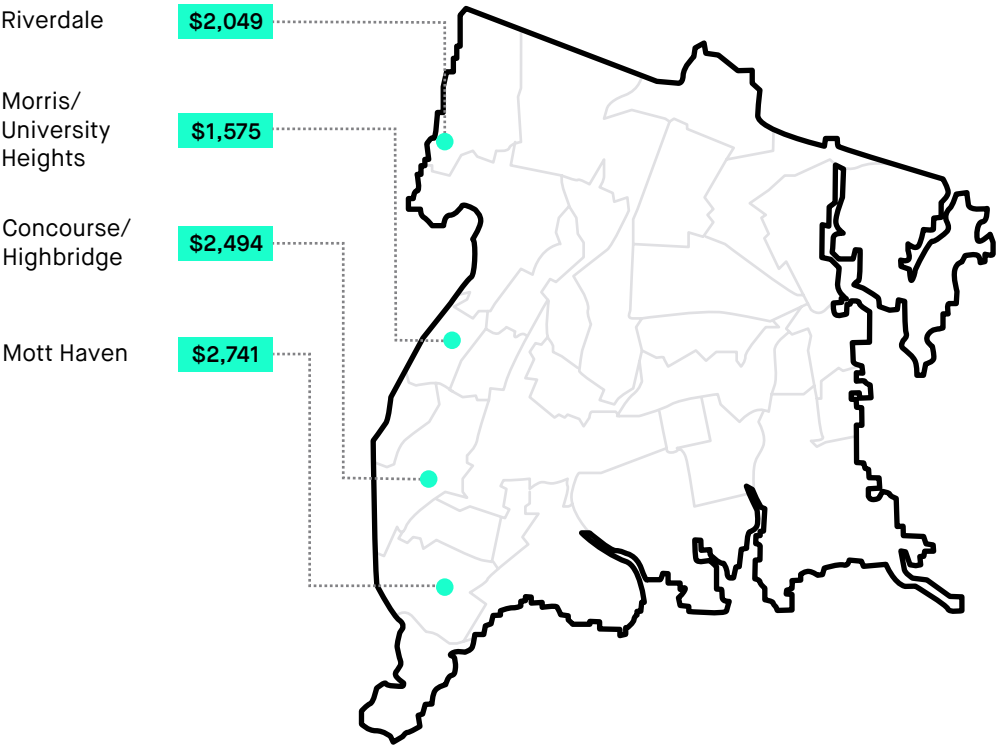

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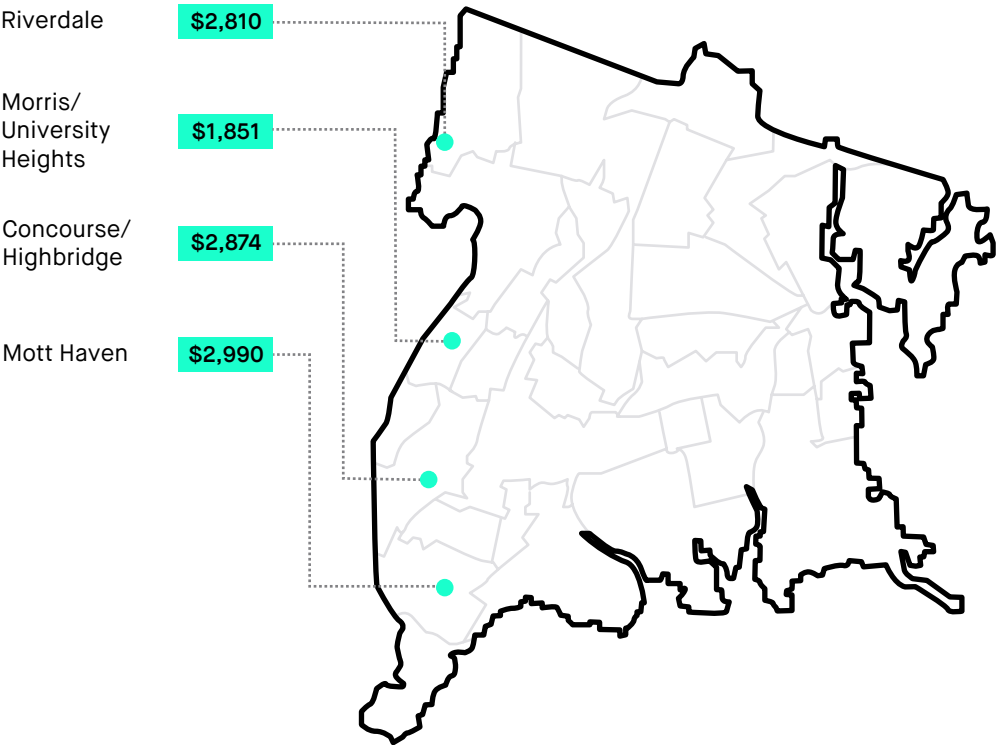

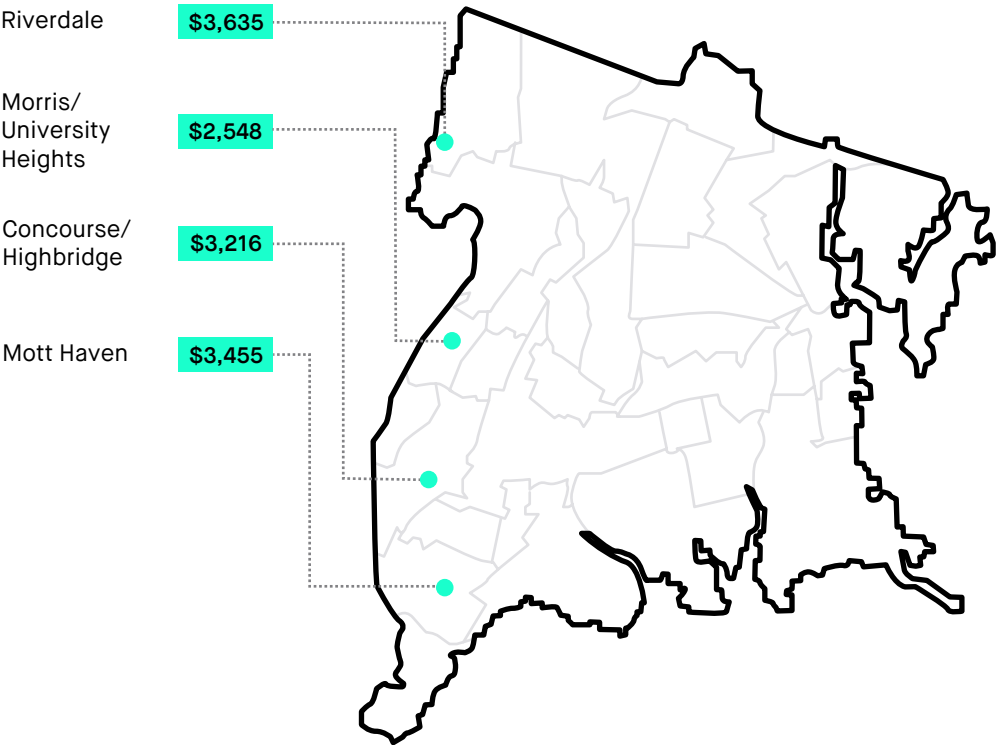

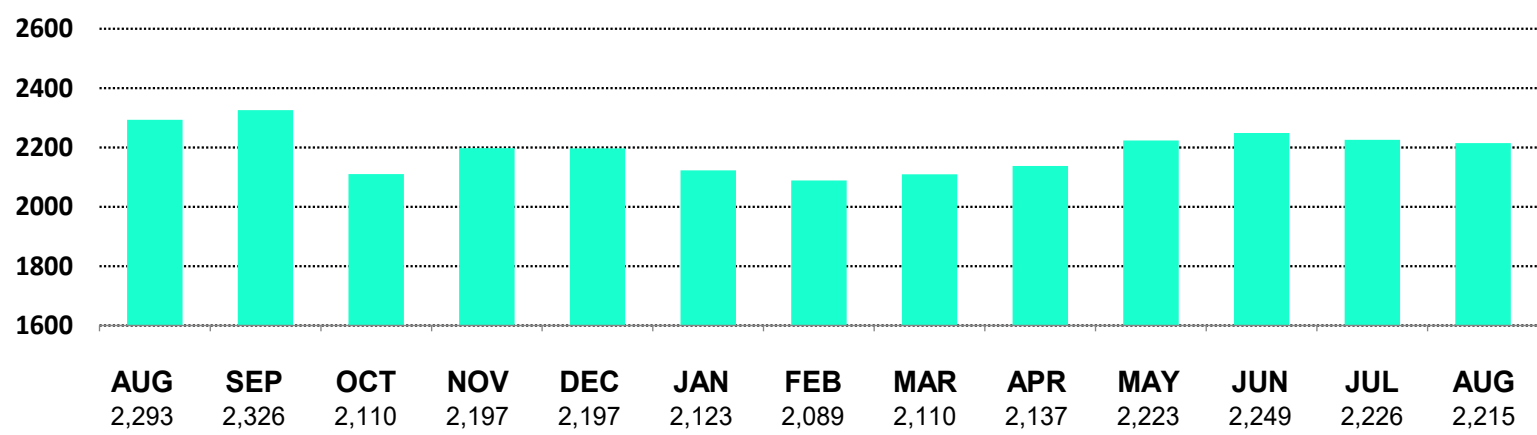

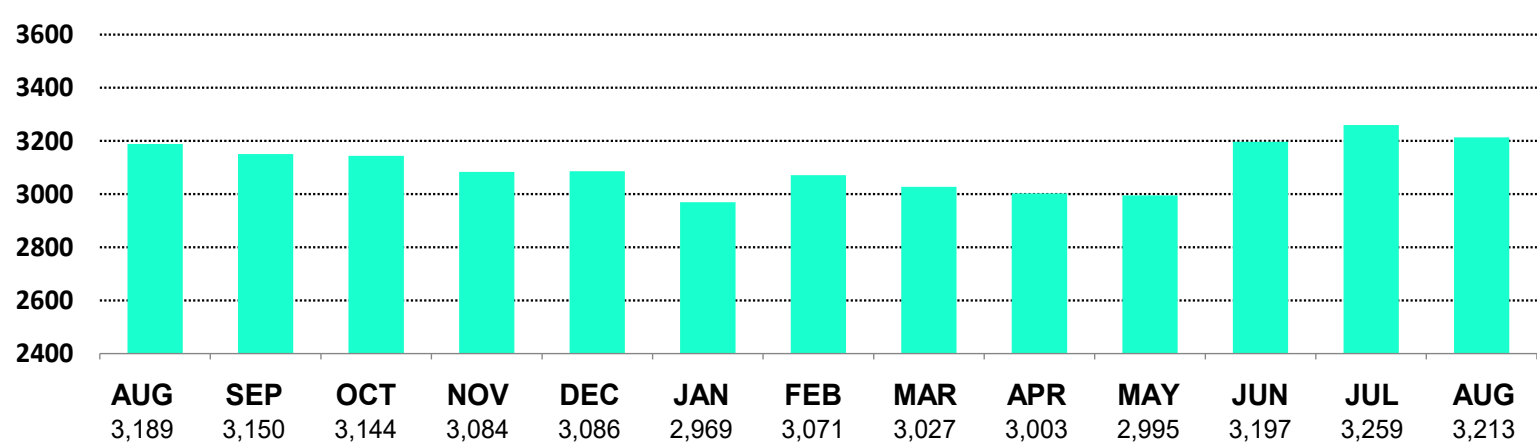
BRONX STUDIO PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



BRONX ONE-BEDROOM PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



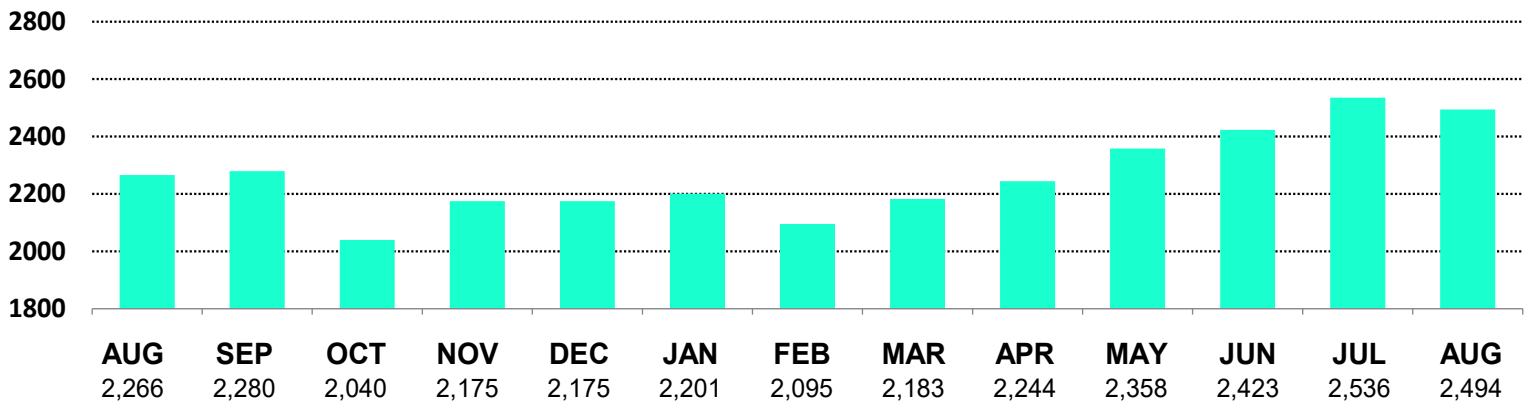

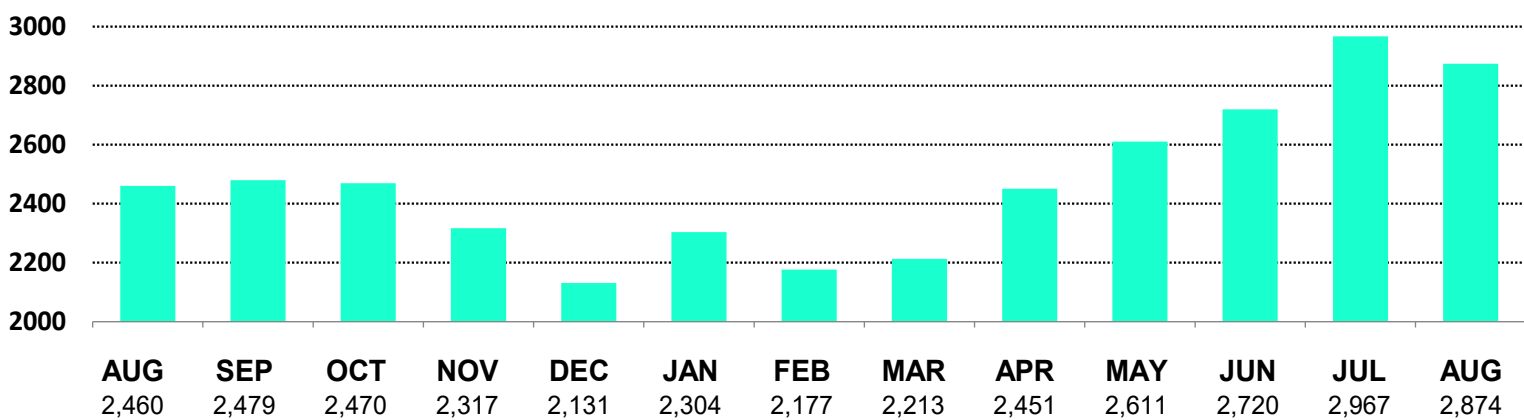

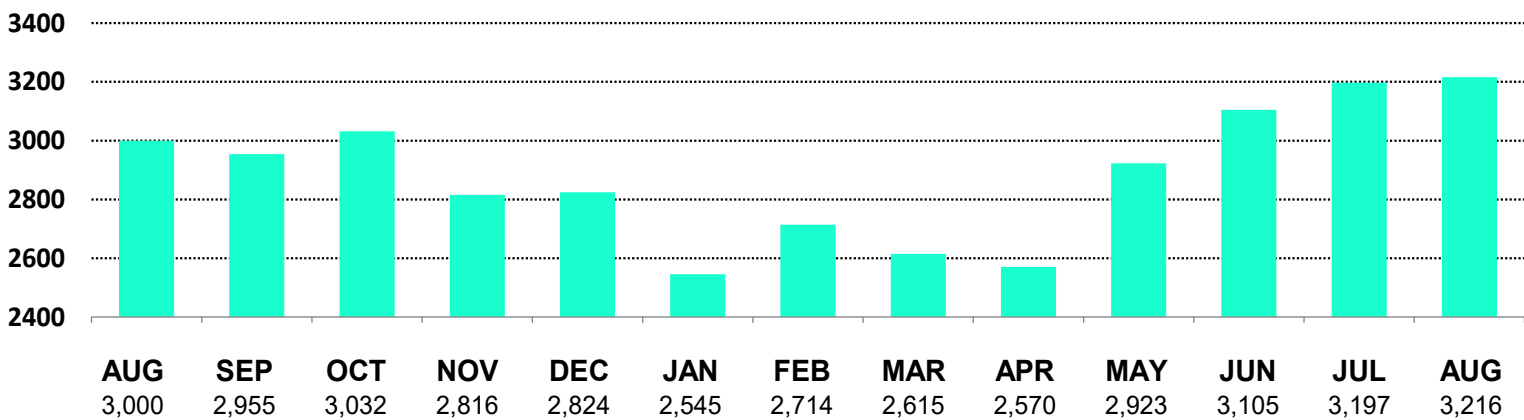
CONCOURSE / HIGHBRIDGE STUDIO PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS

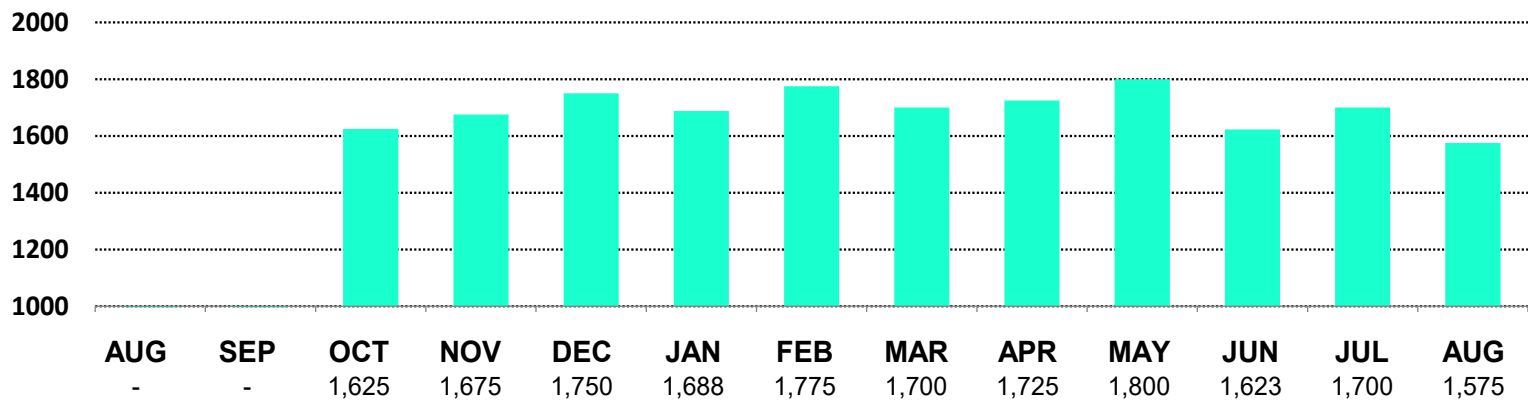

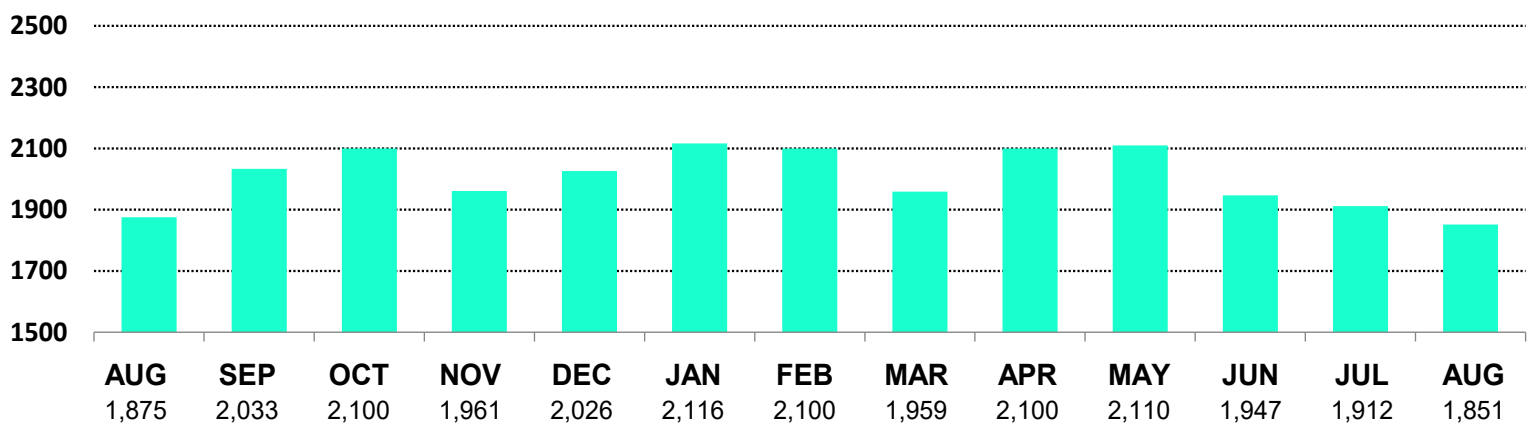

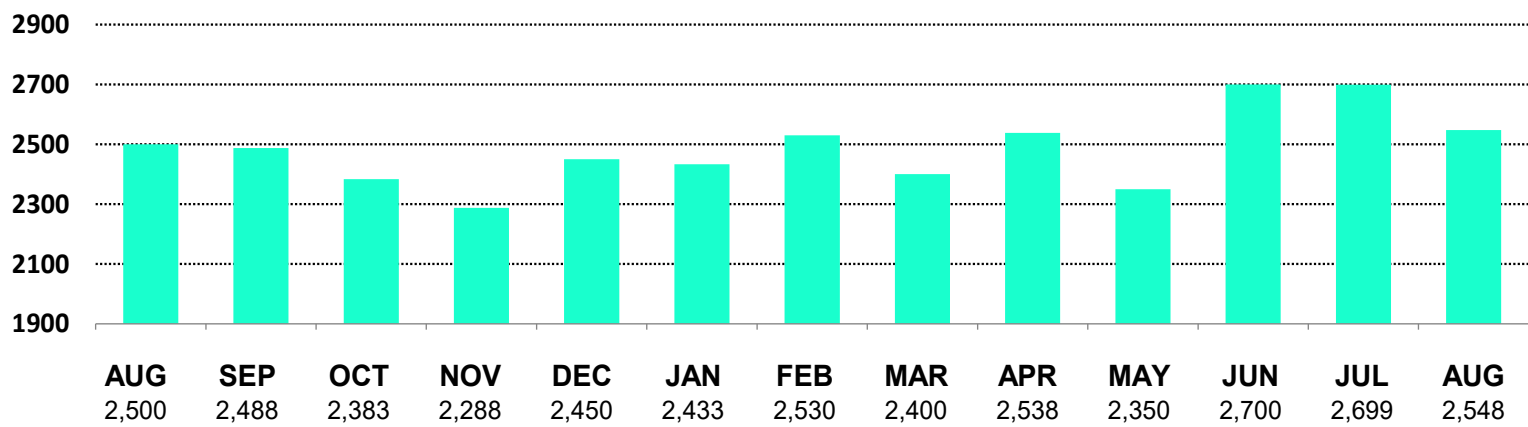
MORRIS HEIGHTS / UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS STUDIO PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



MORRIS HEIGHTS / UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS ONE-BEDROOM PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



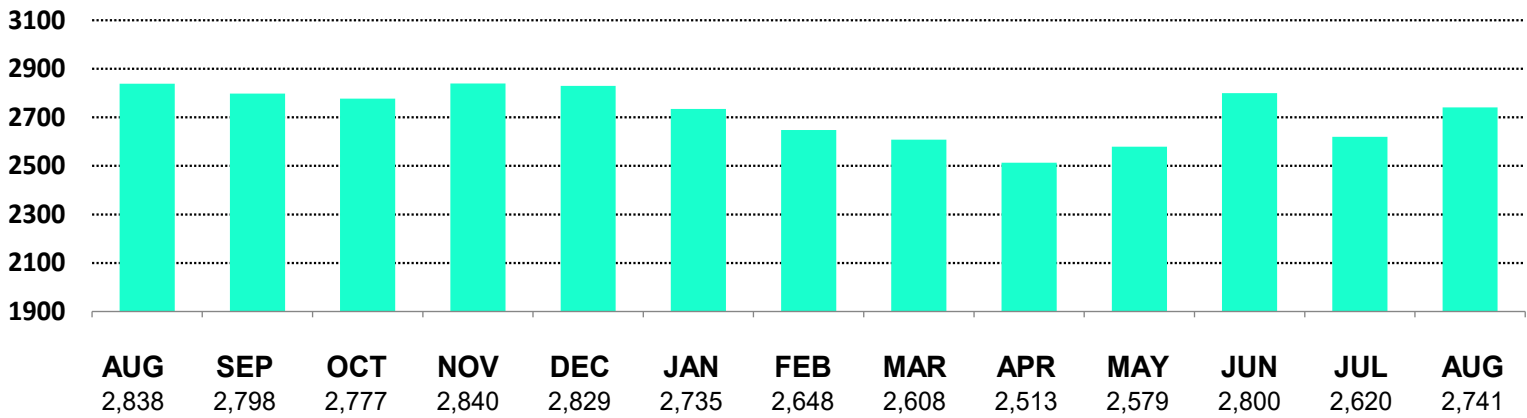
MORRIS HEIGHTS / UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS TWO-BEDROOM PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



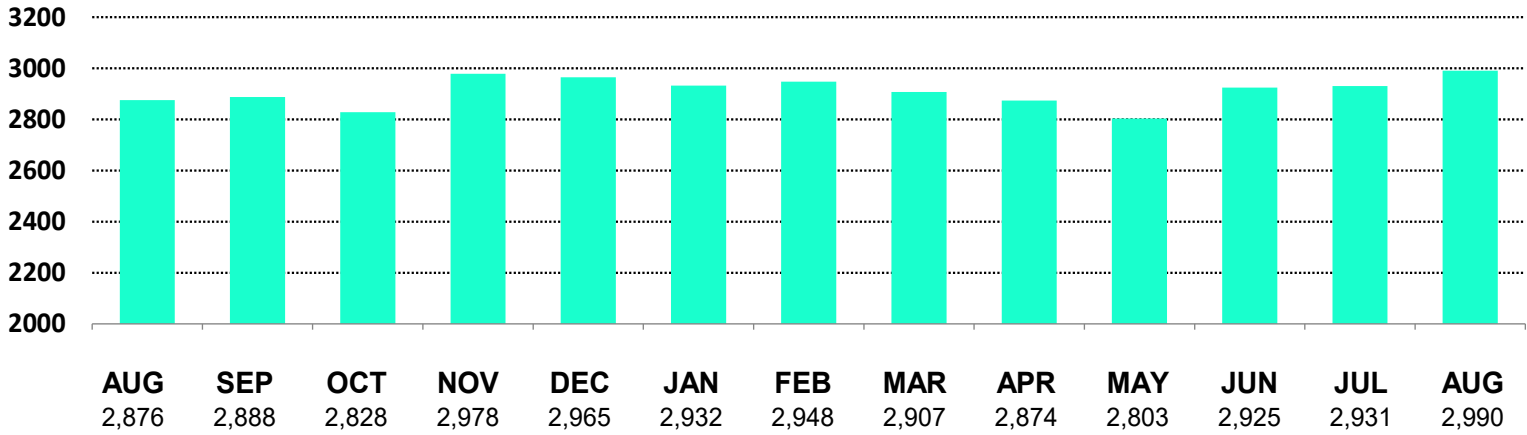

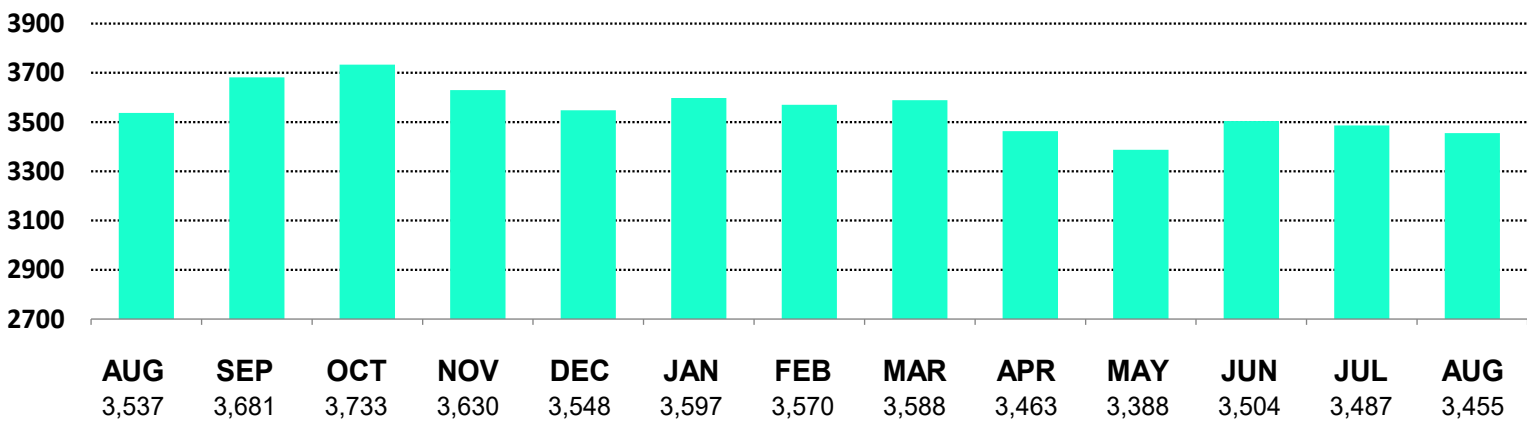
MOTT HAVEN STUDIO PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



MOTT HAVEN ONE-BEDROOM PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS



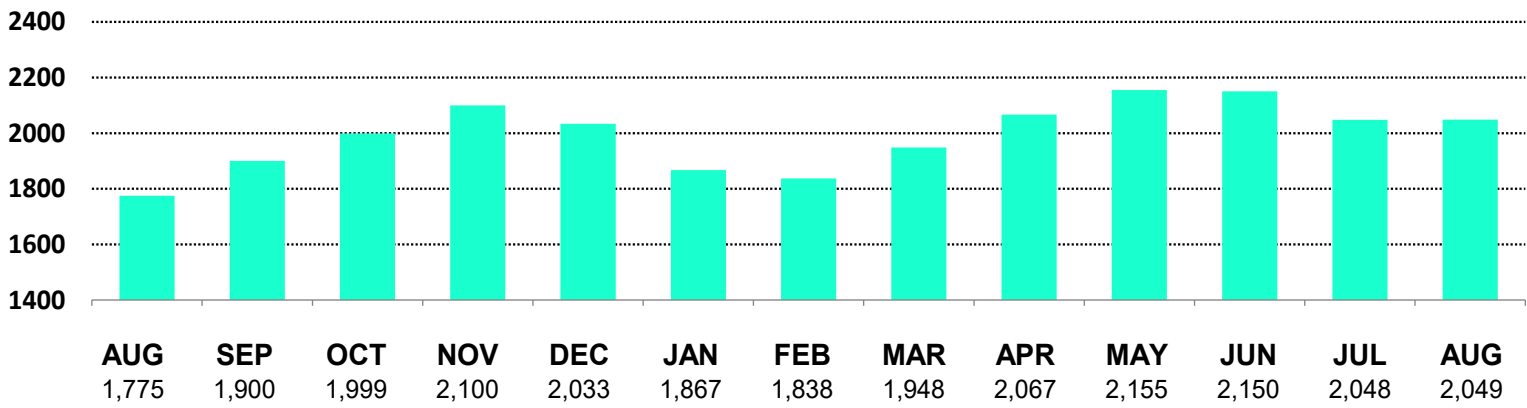

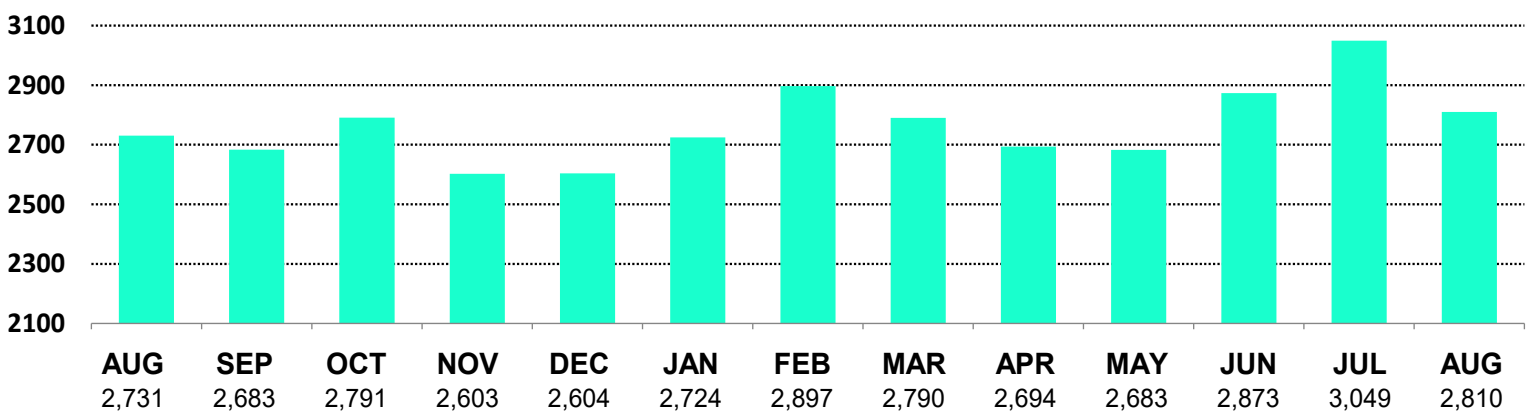

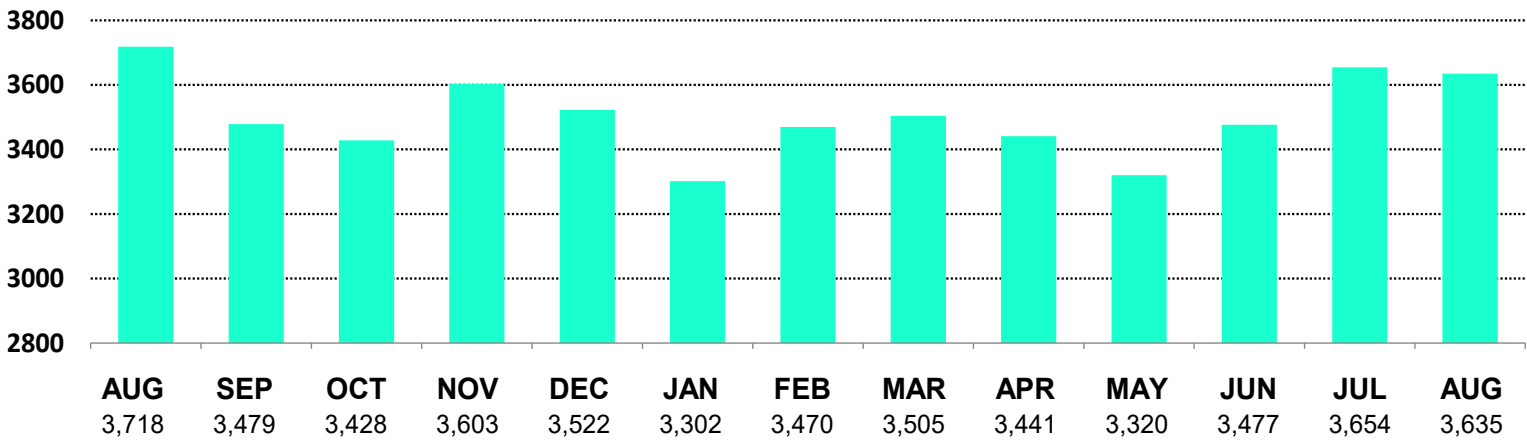
RIVERDALE STUDIO PRICE TRENDS OVER 13 MONTHS

The Bronx Rental Market Report TM is based on a cross-section of data from available listings and priced under \$10,000, with ultraluxury property omitted to obtain a true monthly rental average. Our data is aggregated from the MNS proprietary database and sampled from a specific mid-month point to record current rental rates offered by landlords during that particular month. It is then combined with information from the REBNY Real Estate Listings Source (RLS), OnLine Residential (OLR.com) and R.O.L.E.X. (Real Plus).
