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INTRODUCTION

WE ARE PROUD TO PRESENT MNS' NINTH ANNUAL YEAR END REPORT



MNS is proud to present our ninth annual Year End Report for Queens, the summation of a year's worth of data collected from our monthly Queens Rental Market Reports. We hope you find this report useful in determining the rental trends present in Queens' major neighborhoods, as well as the overall climate of the Queens rental market.

Compared to last year, the average rental prices in Queens for 2024 increased by 5.95%, from \$2,747 in 2023 to \$2,910 this past year. Studio rental prices are up by 7.04% year-over-year, from \$2,192 to \$2,346. The average rental price for one-bedroom units are up by 5.29%, from \$2,671 in 2023 to \$2,812 in 2024. The average rental price for two-bedroom units increased by 5.76%, from \$3,378 to \$3,572.

Growth and Borough Trends

Rego Park saw their average rents increase the most this past year, at 13.27%. Not far behind was Flushing at 9.33%, and Sunnyside with an increase of 10.11%.





2024 MEAN STUDIO RENTAL PRICES



THE QUEENS RENTAL MARKET REPORT IS THE ONLY REPORT THAT COMPARES FLUCTUATION IN THE CITY'S RENTAL DATA ON A MONTHLY BASIS. The Queens Rental Market Report is based on data cross-sectioned from over 10,000 currently available listings priced under \$10,000, with ultra-luxury property omitted to obtain a true monthly rental average. Our data is aggregated from the MNS proprietary database and sampled from a specific mid-month point to record current rental rates offered by landlords during that particular month. It is then combined with information from the REBNY Real Estate Listings Source (RLS), OnLine Residential (OLR. com) and R.O.L.E.X. (Real Plus).
